European Board for the CESMA-UEMS European Exam in Angiology /Vascular Medicine

VAS and the UEMS Division have given rise to the Board of the European Exam in Angiology/Vascular Medicine (BEEAVM) which organises the CESMA-UEMS European Exam to obtain the European Diploma in Angiology/Vascular Medicine

CESMA-UEMS European Exam in A/VM

Every Year, 1 Day Before European Angiology Days, Milan (I).

Part 1a

- One week before the exam, 100 questions are selected from the **database** by the Referees, sent to the central informatic management engineer to upload to the server.
- Once uploaded, access to the 100 questions on database given to the 5 commission members, to revise.
- Multiple choice questions (MCQ) exam takes place in Milan, LITA Building, University of Milan, L. Sacco Hospital. Computers connected to the central server via internet. Duration of the MCQ exam two hours.

Part 1b

- Results of the written exam provided to the commission after the clinical exam expressed as a number of correct answers (out of the 100).
- **The written exam grade represented by the number of correct answers divided by ten.**

Part 2

- Clinical Case Discussion
- Discuss with commission members: clinical exam findings, biological results, non-invasive and invasive exploration findings etc.
- **Duration clinical case exam (30 minutes), Grade (1-10).**

Results

- The final exam grade, represents the average of the two grades. The Commission requires a final grade of at least 6.5 (on a 1-10 scale), in order to validate the exam.

Accreditation of European Training Centres in Angiology/Vascular Medicine (ETC in A/VM)

Who Can Apply?

Where National Accreditation exists, National Scientific Societies should cooperate sending the list of the Centres.

The single Centres, through the Director, can forward the Application.

Any communication/Application should be sent directly to UEMS Headquarters (also from vas web clicking on Contacts).

Which are the first steps to take towards Validation and then Accreditation?

- Centres applying for Accreditation will submit the file to the **Board of the UEMS Division of Angiology/Vascular Medicine** .
- **VAS**, acting in the name of the UEMS Division of Angiology/Vascular Medicine, will **Validate** (Validation process) the fulfilment of criteria (see Training Requirements Document-UEMS Division A/VM).
- Centres applying for Accreditation could receive, during the Validation process, indication to cooperate with smaller Angiology/Vascular Medicine Centres or Centres with other Specialist structures (consistent with the purpose and the training curriculum) to expand the training offer. The Validation process that leads to Accreditation does not represent in any way an evaluation on the quality of the Centre, but follows criteria of harmonisation and qualification process at European level as described above. Where National Accreditation exists, National Scientific Societies could cooperate by sending the list of the Centres operating in their territory .
- In the next step, the **Validated** file will be submitted by VAS to the Board of the **UEMS Division of Angiology/Vascular Medicine for final Accreditation** .

The **Head and the medical staff** of the structure can apply for the **CESMA-UEMS European Diploma** in Angiology/Vascular Medicine, following the curriculum-based rules.

Second Accreditation

Centres already accredited as ETC can apply for a further Accreditation/s in:

- **Arterial interventional Therapy**
- **Venous Procedures**

UEMS, the European Union of Medical Specialists, represents more than 50 medical disciplines and sets standards for high quality healthcare practice that are transmitted to the Authorities and Institutions of the EU .

- **In 2000 the problem of Angiology/Vascular Medicine was raised for the first time by VAS and the creation of an Angiology /Vascular Medicine Division was proposed within the UEMS.**
- VAS obtained the UEMS Division of Angiology/Vascular Medicine approved by the UEMS Council, a fundamental development in the recognition of this specialty in Europe and in individual countries (1st Board Meeting, 2008). Documents with the definition of Angiology/Vascular Medicine and the requirements for training in the specialty (Chapter 6) and its general guidelines (Policy Statement) were approved by the UEMS Council 2012.
- CESMA- UEMS Board also approved the BEEAVM, Board for European Exam in Angiology/Vascular Medicine and the first CESMA-UEMS Exam in Angiology /Vascular Medicine to obtain the CESMA-UEMS European Diploma in Angiology/Vascular Medicine was organized (Milan, 2012).
